Dear Mr Bergrade

I refer to your application dated 16 September 2025 regarding Drawmaster v1.2.

As delegate of the Chief Executive, I have conducted a review of the application. In deciding the application, I had regard to the material information which included the following:

- Submission materials including:
 - Source code and software (**Attachment 1**).
- Random Number Generator Minimum Technical Requirements v1.5

I have considered the objects of the *Charitable and Non-Profit Gaming Act 1999*, which on balance, require the state and the community as a whole benefit from gaming by ensuring the integrity and fairness of games; and minimising the potential for harm from gaming.

I have assessed the application against the relevant criteria under section 100 of the *Charitable and Non-Profit Gaming Act 1999* and the provisions of Random Number Generator Minimum Technical Requirements v1.5.

After considering all relevant factors and information, including your submissions, I have decided to approve the application for Drawmaster v1.2 subject to the following conditions:

Special Conditions

1. Drawmaster v1.2 is approved to be used in accordance with the draw parameters detailed in **Attachment 2**. For Largest Prize Value amounts larger than \$5,000,000 that do not exceed \$10,000,000, either an independent Auditor must sign the draw records document, or the result must be witnessed by the scrutineer at the draw (Justice of the Peace).
2. For Largest Prize Value amounts larger than \$10,000,000 and up to the maximum value of \$20,000,000, the following conditions apply:

- a) The entirety of the draw process, from system initialisation through to final result generation and logging, must be video recorded in full.
- b) Footage must be securely stored for a minimum of five (5) years, consistent with existing obligations under Section 77 of the *Charitable and Non-Profit Gaming Act 1999*.
- c) A copy of the footage for each such draw must be made available to OLGR upon request.
- d) The draw footage must capture the physical presence of the independent Auditor supervising the draw process. The independent Auditor must not be a direct employee of Jumbo Interactive or the entity using the Drawmaster system.
- e) The details of the independent Auditor for this purpose must be provided to OLGR prior to the draw being conducted.
- f) The independent Auditor must physically sign a hard copy of the draw records document, and this must be witnessed by an approved scrutineer, who must be an authorised person under the *Oaths Act 1867* (Qld). This signed and witnessed draw records document must be submitted to OLGR – this may be submitted as part of the existing Form 3A return process, provided that the material is lodged within the applicable prescribed timeframe following completion of the draw.
- g) The independent Auditor details and draw records document should be directed to: olgrlicensing@justice.qld.gov.au

- 3. The Win Chance parameter must not be used for draws conducted under the *Charitable and Non-Profit Gaming Act 1999*.

This approval is also subject to the following standard conditions:

- 1. The applicant maintaining all necessary licences, approvals, consents, permissions and assignments to perform the actions or carry out the activities contemplated by this approval without infringing the intellectual property rights of any third parties.
- 2. OLGR is to be immediately notified of any problems identified with the above system. These problems include any known or suspected adverse impact on integrity or performance. Such reports must be sent to olgrnotify@justice.qld.gov.au.

The equipment must not be enabled for use for the purpose of general gaming until all other general gaming legislative requirements are met.

Jumbo Interactive must ensure the ongoing satisfactory performance of Drawmaster v1.2 under live conditions. OLGR takes no responsibility for the above system should it be found to have other problems or be otherwise unsuitable for use in another jurisdictions, either now or in the future.

Please be advised that this letter supersedes the previous approval letter (Ref No. OGR-2581055) for the software item Drawmaster v1.2 dated 9 March 2026, which had a Largest Prize Value of \$10,000,000.

This approval should not reduce or mitigate the obligations of the licensee to adhere to all Federal statutory obligations such as the *Anti-Money Laundering and Counter-Terrorism Financing Act 2006*.

If you wish to apply for a review of my decision as delegate of the Chief Executive, this must be done within 28 days of receipt of this advice. Applications for review may be lodged with:
